## **AWARDS RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Must be a current S.S.W.A. Member prior to the catch or kill of trophy
- 2. All trophies entered must be taken within Saskatchewan in the current year
  - \* Fish caught in border lakes that recognize a Saskatchewan License also count as caught within Saskatchewan
- 3. It is the responsibility of the owner to enter their trophy to the S.S.W.A. Awards Committee
- 4. All fish and game birds taken must be weighed on a digital scale by a neutral person
- 5. Big game animals must be scored by Boone & Crocket, Henry Kelsey and Pope & Young standards
- 6. Big game must be scored by an official scorer
- 7. S.S.W.A. Minimum Qualifying Weights are:

Walleye 1.588 kg/3.5 lb; Pike 2.9 kg/6.4 lb; Perch 0.2948 kg/0.65 lb; Whitefish 1.134 kg/2.5 lb; Rainbow Trout 1.134 kg/2.5 lb; Brook Trout 0.454 kg/1.0 lb; Lake Trout 2.585 kg/5.7 lb;

Largemouth Bass 1.09 kg/2.4 lb

8. Adult Champion Angler (17 years of age and over):

The total weight of three fish species with a combination including: 1 Pike;

1 Walleye; 1 Lake Trout; 2 Whitefish; 2 Rainbow Trout; 2 Largemouth Bass;

2 Brook Trout; or 3 Perch.

Ex: you could have 1 Pike, 1 Walleye and 2 Rainbow Trout

9. Junior and Novice Angler trophies will be calculated by the S.S.W.A. Minimum Qualifying Weight divided into the actual weight, multiplied by 100 = percentage

Ex: Walleye 2.626 kg divided by 1.588 kg x 100 = 168.5%

OR in imperial weights 5.9lb divided by 3.5 x 100 = 168.5%

- \* The fish with the highest percentage based on the S.S.W.A. Minimum Qualifying Weights per fish category will be the winner
- 10. Junior Hunters: 16 years of age and under
- 11. Best Big Game with a Rifle (Rifle Trophy)

Best Big Game with a Musket (Black Powder Trophy)

Calculated by the Henry Kelsey minimum score divided into the actual score, multiplied by 100 = percentage

Ex. Moose 175: 165/175 x 100 = 94.28%
